Ulrich A. Sante appointed Vice Chairman

LBBW brings in high-ranking diplomat to strengthen international business

LBBW has acquired a renowned international relations expert in order to enhance its consulting expertise in international business. Dr Ulrich A. Sante, most recently German ambassador to Argentina, will join the management of LBBW on August 1. For example, the 65-year-old has worked at the embassies in Vilnius, Washington, and Madrid and at the Permanent Representations of the Federal Republic of Germany to the EU and later NATO in Brussels. He was appointed ambassador to Singapore in 2017 before taking charge of the Embassy in Buenos Aires in 2020.
